If you are serious about booking a session with One Viision Productions, it is suggested you read the items below, before contacting OVP with any questions, that could have been answered by reading this****

-What is a TFP/TFCD shoot, and what does it entail?

A TFP/TFCD shoot, or a Trade For Print(s)/Trade for CD shoot, is an agreement and understanding, between the photographer & model(and if a MUA/Stylist/etc.), in which no money exchanges hands, only the property...Instead of any money, everyone involved in the shoot, feels that they can add to each other's portfolio, provided good, quality, photo's....The model is given a CD-ROM disc, with the image selections burned onto the disc, and/or a link with a .zip file of the selected images....

-Will, One Viision Productions do TFP/TFCD shoot?

Yes, but not as much as regular, paid, portfolio work...If the model is unique, and I feel has something, a look, style, idea that we can both benefit from, then it, or a reduced-rate is negotiable...

-As a model, what do I keep, have the right to use?

I can provide digital links to your work, and a CD-ROM of the best, touched-up images to you, that you can use for promotional/portfolio...You will not be given the .RAW, layered, or any other untouched image from the session...If, the model wanted one, or two to touch-up on their own, that can be negotiated on a picture-to-picture basis...

-Because it is a “free” shoot, does that compromise the quality of the images?

No...As a professional, I will treat the shoot with the utmost respect, care and dignity, as I would to all of my shoots...Just because no money exchanges hands, does not mean I do not have an emotional attachment to the work, or project...Everyone needs to work together, because it is my reputation, the model's, MUA's, etc. so, hopefully everyone brings their “A” game...

This can be difficult for a new model, because they are not sure on how to act, or portray themselves in front of the camera...I will work with you, to try and make you feel comfortable about/during the shoot, so we can achieve the best images that day...And I trust you, to be able to take direction, be professional, and have a good attitude!

As a beginning model, I'll work with you before/during the shoot, to try and capture the look, style, and attitude you want to portray. Same for experienced model's, let's work together, to achieve the goal we set out to create!

-Will you provide a Make-Up Artist, Stylist, or any other creative personnel?

As for right now, no...There have been times, when and MUA, model, and photographer want to collaborate on a joint TF session, but I would suggest finding one, yourself...It's good to pick a friend, that you can communicate your idea's too, helping you/us achieve, the best look for you...If you can't find, or trust someone you know to achieve this, then do it yourself, you know you, better than anyone!

-What about wardrobe?

No, I do not cover wardrobe...It is best to bring your own clothes, props, jewelry, etc. Whatever you think, you will need, for this particular shoot...For a studio/field/location shoots, bring a robe, wrap, or something to cover yourself with, if you need it...

-Do you have a studio-space? If not, where do we shoot?

I do not have one, at this present time...But, there are tons of different things we can do, to achieve what you are looking for...Locations, houses, garden's, public arena's, field's, bridges, courtyards, abandoned buildings, plaza's, beaches, anywhere can be used as a backdrop!

-What if I want a simple headshot, or a basic shot?

If that is all you want, you can come to my residence and I will set up some lights, and a backdrop to capture the photo needed...If you feel more comfortable in your residence, or a friend that has one better equipped with what you need, a travel fee is included...

-Can I bring music, food, drinks, etc. to the shoot?

If you would like to bring music, that will help you during the shoot, I'm all for it...If not, I have an extensive music collection and a lot of genre's...

Food and drinks are not allowed, after make-up and wardrobe have been applied...You may eat beforehand, or right after the shoot is finished...This is so nothing happens to compromise the shoot, make-up, or wardrobe, and no one waste's each other's time...It is not the photographer's responsibility to provide refreshments...

Cell phones, pager's, pda's, any and all, electronic devices(excluding music, if wished for) are to be turned off, while on set...This means the photographer, too

-Are escorts, and other companion's allowed on set?

No, not unless it is a make-up artist, stylist, etc. If you would like to bring one to a nude, or nude TF shoot, I have no problem with that...In all situations, the photographer is to act with the utmost respect, and professional demeanor, adhering to the client's wishes, and level of security...

I do not shoot models nude, under the age of 18

The model is required to bring some sort of, government issued photo identification

When a shoot is booked, you have up to 48 hrs. to cancel the shoot, if you book a shoot and do not show up, you are fired

Nude Semi-Nude Implied-Nude Adult Photography

There are a few, different types of nude photography that are an option to consider, what you want out of the shoot, and what you want to portray with the images...These are ways, I have classified some common conditions, situations, and types of photography that can take place, during nude

photography...If you have any questions, concerns, or need for clarity, please contact me...

-What does the term, "figure study" mean?

Figure study, is the same thing as "figure nude", a lot of novice's do not understand that, and are taken aback when asked to pose nude...There are many different types of Figure Nudes possible, and many different ways to shoot them...

-An Implied Nude- The model is not required to take off their clothes, but the picture's can, and are supposed to look, as if it were a nude...No clothing is shown in the picture, the "illusion", is that since no clothes are visible, none are being worn...These photo's are common in major publications, like a men's magazine(FHM, Maxim), or a print advertisement, to give you an idea...

-Covered Nude- The model is not wearing any clothes in this photographic situation, but a drape, blanket, your/my arms, or some other opaque prop is used to cover your private areas... These photo's are common in major publications, like a men's magazine(FHM, Maxim), or a print advertisement, as well...

-Translucent/Lingerie/See-Through- The model is not wearing any clothes, but there is a some, see-through, or sheer material covering an area of your body, and private areas...We can talk about how clear the material is beforehand, and this will depend on how exposed you are...This could be any risque piece of lingerie, chemise, hosiery, etc.
If you are still confused, go to Google, Images, type in Rose McGowan and look for the photo of her with Marilyn Manson at the Grammy's...

-Semi-Nude Photography- The model is naked, with the face, breasts and behind of the model exposed, at the same time and in the same shot...Your pose, and lighting would depend in this scenario...Think of a playful, profiled, semi-nude, pin-up girl, or early, adult magazine's(Playboy, circa 1950's, 1960's)...

-Artistic Nude Photography- The model is naked, and is shot in a creative matter, poses, lighting, concept, etc. I cite the work of John Emrys, his exemplary photo examples address this, well... <http://www.iconophile-ltd.com/main.php?rSection=s3r>

-Figure Nude/Figure Study- The model is naked, with the entire form exposed(face, private's, top-to-bottom), but in silhouetted form...These are not a sexually-charged photo, they are celebration of a body's, form, line, physique, etc. Celebrated photographer, Alex Wilson portrays a good example of this... <http://alexwilsonphoto.com/gallery/>

-Nude Photography- The model is fully nude, and is shot in direct-lighting, no playful silhouetting, lighting contrasts, drapes, etc. A website that does this tastefully, is <http://www.domai.com>

-Erotic- The model is fully naked, shot in direct lighting, acting provocative, with a lot of attention/enhancement, on the model's private areas...These shots are more reserved for adult themed magazine publication's(Penthouse) soft-pornography, website's(Suicide Girls), etc
